

TOWN OF BIG FLATS - TOWN BOARD MEETING

November 9, 2022 - 6:00 PM

Call to Order: Chairman Reed called the meeting to order @ 6:02 PM. The pledge was recited.

Bills and Payroll: Supervisor Clark made a motion to pay bills, Supervisor Kipfer 2nd, all in favor.

October Meeting Minutes: Supervisor Clark made a motion to accept minutes, Supervisor Kipfer 2nd, all in favor.

Treasurers Report: Town Treasurer read balances, debits, and credits for all town accounts. No comments or questions were made, Chairman Reed asked that the reports to be filed for audit.

Fire Department Report: Chief Meyers reported there were two ATV accidents where there was one rollover and one injury. Eight medical assists, one wildland fire of about one acre, the DNR was called for it. One vehicle fire, one mutual aid for Rome of a Deck Fire, one mutual aid for a chimney fire for Adams, and one mutual aid for New Chester fire on County M @ Bula Farms. There was also eight other calls, 2 LP incidents one cook stove leak one hose leak, and 6 Lift Assists. 16 FD personnel attended the Enbridge Pipeline presentation, some attended Hunting Accident Training. They had their Pump tests and Hydro testing done. 501 needs valves. There was a total of 18 calls in the town of Big Flats and 2 calls in the town of Monroe.

Committee Reports: Jay Jocham reported on the Zoning activity for the township. There were two site inspections conducted and one approval made. He mailed eleven zoning compliance letters, six have responded and begun compliance. The other 5 have not replied and campers were still in place on November 2. Jay state he had forwarded those 5 to the town attorney for legal actions be mailed by November 9. Jay also stated two RV compliance letters had been mailed out. He also reported one old mobile had not been moved from 1317 Badger Ave, and one old mobile was moved onto 1006 St. Rd 13. He responded to 16 phone inquiries and 2 emails.

Plan Commission Meeting: Chairman Reed announced the next Plan Commission meeting will be on November 16, @ 6:00 PM.
